**MOVING IN TO YOUR**

***BLUEBOOK***

One of the best things to do with your *Bluebook* is to tab it or flag important pages. This will help you become more familiar with the Bluebook and make you more efficient in accessing the Rules you need later during a writing assignment.

# NECESSARY TABS

Here's my list of necessary tabs for any  
*Bluebook*:

- BT1
- Parentheticals (Rule 1.5)
- Introductory Signals (Rule 1.2)
- T6

# T1

I also recommend tabbing jurisdictions in which you commonly practice in T1.

# RULE 18

Another tab you might consider is Rule 18, which covers Internet and other electronic sources. In today's world, these types of sources are becoming more common.

If you find yourself coming back to a Rule that isn't tabbed, go ahead and tab it to save yourself time later.
