TRICKY RULES

E.G.,

The comma after the “e.g.” introductory signal is not italicized, but the comma before the signal is.

“AT”

Do not use “at” before the section or paragraph symbol.

ID.

Do not use *id.* for internal cross-references.

In practical legal documents, do not use *id.* for record cites unless it would save significant space.

CASE NAMES

“Always retain in full the first word in each party’s name (including a relator),” except as otherwise provided in Rule 10.2.1.

NOTE: If a word is in T6, it is *always* abbreviated, even if it is the first word of a party name.
